Content (Syllabus outline):

Rituals are a feature of all known human societies. They include not only the worship rites and sacraments of organized religions and cults, but also rites of passage, atonement and purification rites, oaths of allegiance, dedication ceremonies, coronations and presidential inaugurations, marriages and funerals, school graduations, club meetings, sporting events, Halloween parties, parades, Christmas shopping and more. Many activities that are ostensibly performed for concrete purposes, such as jury trials, execution of criminals, and scientific

Cilji in kompetence:

Cilj predmeta je seznaniti študente z temeljnimi pojmi in problemi obredov kot družbenih fenomenov v kulturno-zgodovinskem in družbenem kontekstu. Na ta način bodo pridobili teoretsko znanje o preteklih in sodobnih družbenih odnosih, kot se ti pojavljajo v modernih in postmodernih zgodovinskih razmerah.

Poleg podajanja temeljnih poglavij iz zgodovine obredov je osrednji cilj njihova aktualizacija v razmerju do sodobne umetnosti in kulture; nadalje želi predmet spodbuditi k refleksiji in znanstvenemu raziskovanju vloge obredov med družbenimi vedami ter v kontekstu širše humanistične misli.

S podajanjem novejših znanstvenih spoznanj je namen predmeta spodbuditi k raziskovanju in refleksiji o ideoloških mehanizmih v umetnosti in kulturi ter spodbuditi h gojenju samostojnega in kritičnega mišljenja nasploh. Predmet želi pomagati študentom razviti metodološke in analitične sposobnosti ter jih usposobiti za akademsko poglobljeno izražanje in argumentacijo ter umeščanje v širši družbeno-kulturni kontekst.

Objectives and competences:

The objective of this course is to acquaint the students with the key concepts and issues of the rituals as social phenomena within its cultural-historical and social contexts. In such a manner they will gain theoretical knowledge on historical and contemporary social relationships, as they appear in modern and postmodern historic circumstances.

In addition to giving the key subjects from the history of the rituals the main objective is the actualization of these subjects in relation to the contemporary art and culture; the aim is also to encourage the reflexion and scientific research on the role of the rituals within social sciences and in the context of a broader humanistic thought.

By giving the actual scientific knowledge the aim of the course is to encourage the research and reflexion on the ideological mechanisms in art and culture, and to encourage to foster independent and critical thought in general. The course is intended to help students to develop methodological and analytical skills, qualify them for academically competent expression and argumentation, as well as contextualization in a wider socio-cultural context.

Metode poučevanja in učenja:

Predavanja potekajo frontalno, vendar se spodbuja aktivno sodelovanje študentov. Za seminar študenti pripravljajo domače naloge, s katerimi prenašajo znanje (obravnavane problematike in koncepte) na praktične primere in ga tako preverjajo ter utrjujejo. Opravljene naloge predstavijo na seminarju, kjer se jih prediskutira. Študenti oddajo seminarske naloge v pisni obliki.

Learning and teaching methods:

The lectures take place frontally, yet the active participation of students is highly stimulated. For the seminar the students make seminar works, with which they transpose their knowledge (the discussed problems and concepts) to the practical cases and in such a manner they check and consolidate their knowledge. The seminar work is to be presented and discussed and is to be handed over to the professor in a written form.
